**FALL BASEBALL RULES**

**League Directors: Bob Hetu 282-0755 (H), Dan Kennedy 282-0755

**Play by American Legion rules (see ctalbb.com) with limited exceptions.**

**Teams can draw players from outside their normal Plan A boundaries. However, teams can not take players from a town with a team in our league - without the permission of the affected teams and the league directors.**

**Teams with the assistance of the league, and within certain limitations, will be allowed to set their own schedules.**

**Players must be eligible to play legion baseball in 2010 - be born in 1991 or after for 19 & Under Division and be born in 1993 or after for 17 & Under Division.**

**For the regular season there will be separate wood and metal bat divisions - metal bats will be allowed in the end of the season tournament.**

**A roster form listing the players' names, parent's addresses, birthdates, and ages must be sent in prior to Sept. 10th. No player can play in the playoffs unless they are listed on this roster and attend at least 40% of their teams' scheduled games.**

**A check for \$400 for League Fees (Insurance; Umpires & Trophies for tournament) should be sent to the Connecticut Baseball Academy, 525 Burnside Avenue, East Hartford, CT 06108 made payable to Super East Baseball.**

**Can bat an extra hitter (10th hitter) - EH. DH is not allowed, all pitchers must hit.**

**Starters can re-enter the game once. Must be in the same spot in the batting order.**

**Standings will be determined by awarding certain points for each win, tie, and loss. No points will be awarded for games not played. No points will be awarded for games played after a to be specified date.**

**Games played during the week on unlighted fields do not have to go the regulation distance to be counted as a complete game.**

**All teams will qualify for a single elimination tournament at the end of the season. The tournament dates will be specified by our second meeting.**

**There are no protests in the fall, the league directors and umpires have the final say.**

**There is no automatic mercy rule. An individual coach, when behind by a "large" margin after 5 innings, can decide to concede the victory to the other team.**

**Home teams will provide all the necessary game balls (Rawlings CT-AL) . Each team will pay for half the umpires cost at each game.**

**Pitching - 12 innings (Seniors) and 10 innings (Junior) in each 3 day rolling period**

**Need to limit changes to your final schedule and be flexible in completing schedule**
